Stitch count is 159W x 159L, using 51 DMC colors

Finished design size (approximate):

14-count: 11.36 x 11.36 inches

16-count: 9.94 x 9.94 inches

18-count: 8.83 x 8.83 inches

22-count: 7.23 x 7.23 inches

25-count: 6.36 x 6.36 inches

Note: The fabric should be cut (at a minimum) with an additional 2-3" on each side to allow for framing. If you use 16-count fabric, for example, it should be cut to a minimum of 14" x 14".

Pattern Instructions

1. A black arrow on the top and/or left-hand side of each page indicates the center of the design.
2. The pattern chart spans 9 pages and is laid out as described by the figure that follows. Note that page 9 has no stitches. A hatched area in the chart defines the 3-stitch overlap area from pages to the left of and/or above the current page.

3. Use 2 strands of embroidery floss for 14-, 16-count, and 18-count fabric, use 1 strand of floss for 22- and 25-count fabric.
